

CRC/TRR205 Young Scientist Adrenal Club

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The CRC/TRR205 Young Scientist Adrenal Club (YSA-Club) is designed to facilitate the scientific exchange of all Young Scientists within the CRC/TRR205. It helps PhD/MD candidates and young postdocs to improve their scientific background on adrenal research. Furthermore, soft skills will be improved by the organization of the workshop and the presentation of the own scientific work. Additionally a critical analysis of an unknown manuscript is required for the presentation during the Journal club.

it is obligatory for all PhD/MD students of the CRC/TRR205 and associated projects

Schedule

CRC/TRR205 Young Scientist Adrenal Club is coordinated by the CRC/TRR205 Young Scientist Coordinator (Nicole.bechmann@uniklinikum-dresden.de). The coordinator is responsible for the annual schedule. The annual schedule appoints the presenting scientists and the scientist which are responsible for the organization of the meeting.

Necessary modifications to the schedule must be promptly indicated to the CRC/TRR205 Young Scientist Coordinator. The YSA-Club schedule is published on the CRC/TRR205 homepage (www.adrenal-research.de).

Organization

The CRC/TRR205 Young Scientist Adrenal Club is organized by one PhD/MD candidate at each partner site. Every member of the CRC/TRR 205 TAC-Programme is once a year responsible to organize the location and technical equipment at his/her institution for the journal club. The annual planning is coordinated by the CRC/TRR205 Young Scientist Coordinator.



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The YSA-Club organizer is responsible to organize a suitable room and the necessary equipment to hold a web conference via DFN (https://www.vc.dfn.de/en/web-conferencing/). The organizer is furthermore liable to inform the other participants of his/her institution 1 week in advance in which room the video conference will take place. He/she furthermore introduces the presenters and leads the scientific discussion at the respective institution (chairman). At institutions where only one PhD/MD candidate is resident the PhD/MD candidate has to organize the web conference on its own.

One of the organizers has to fill in and send back the attendance list to the CRC/TRR205 Young Scientist Coordinator. This is necessary to register for Credit Points.

Frequency

Each PhD/MD candidate should present their scientific work once a year within the framework of the CRC/TRR 205 YSA-Club. In addition, each candidate should present a selected manuscript once a year during the Journal Club.

This also applies to associated members to ensure the scientific exchange within the CRC/TRR 205.

Scientific presentation

General: 20 min presentation of the own scientific work and 10 min discussion

The scientific presentation should focus on the own scientific work, should reflect the current status and further steps within the PhD/MD project. In a comparable way **clinician scientists** should present their scientific work once a year within the framework of the CRC/TRR 205 Young Scientist Adrenal Club.

Journal Club

General: 15 min presentation of a selected manuscript on adrenal research and 5 min discussion

Each PhD/MD candidate is responsible to select a suitable manuscript for the CRC/TRR205 Young Scientist Adrenal Club. The manuscript must be send to all CRC/TRR205 Young Scientists and to the CRC/TRR205 Young Scientist Coordinator one week before presentation (use the mailing list: trr205-young-scientists@groups.tu-dresden.de).

In general, the manuscript should not be from the own working group or from another member of the CRC/TRR205. Aim of the Journal Club is to open the scientific spectrum and to discuss the work and the manuscript of different working groups.

The manuscript should be chosen on the following criteria:

- (a) Relevance for CRC/TRR205 adrenal research community;
- (b) Scientific claim



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(c) different scientific topic than the own research.

Furthermore, it is possible to present manuscripts on new methods that could be important for other CRC/TRR205 members.

Credit Points

The participation on the CRC/TRR205 Young Scientist Adrenal Club is obligatory for each PhD/MD candidate and is rewarded with 1 Credit Point. Scientific presentations and presenting of a Journal Club are rewarded with 3 Credit Points. Each PhD/MD candidate is responsible for a proper documentation within the CRC/TRR205 Course Book.
